5. Records Available Upon Request

Records that may be requested in terms of PAIA include, subject to applicable legislation:

- Company records
- Client-related records
- Financial records
- Operational records
- Statutory records

Access to these records may be refused on lawful grounds as set out in PAIA.

6. Protection of Personal Information

Doornhoek processes personal information in accordance with the Protection of Personal Information Act, 4 of 2013 (POPIA). Further details are set out in the Doornhoek Privacy Policy available on the website.

7. Request Procedure

Requests for access to information must be submitted in writing to the Information Officer. The requester may be required to complete the prescribed PAIA request form and pay the applicable fees, if any.

8. Availability of the Manual

This PAIA Manual is available for inspection upon request and is published on the Doornhoek website in compliance with section 51 of PAIA.
